1. Main purpose of the job

- a. To provide psychosocial assistance to unaccompanied refugee minors
- b. To coordinate and facilitate life-skills group sessions for the shelter minors

2. Duties and responsibilities:

- a. Support, oversee and provide psychosocial assistance to refugee minors
- b. Psychiatric evaluation when needed as well as crisis follow up support
- c. Provide individual sessions for difficult cases in collaboration with shelter psychologist and make referrals to specialized psychiatric work as well as external mental health providers, when needed
- d. Coordinate and facilitate life-skill workshops, psychosocial activities, social actions with the support from social workers
- e. Build relationships and oversee wellbeing of minors from general population
- f. Attend and contribute to HCP (Holistic Care Plan)
- g. Attend and contribute to weekly psychosocial meetings
- h. Inform and give feedback to social workers on wellbeing of minors under their care

- b. Experience in provision of psychosocial care to vulnerable groups
- c. Licensed to practice psychology
